ARTICLE 1. MUNICIPAL COURT

- 9-101 ESTABLISHED. A municipal court of the City of Washington, Kansas, is hereby created and established to be presided over by a municipal judge.
- 9-102 CODE OF PROCEDURE. The provisions of the Kansas Code of Procedure for Municipal Courts, being Chapter 12, Articles 41 to 46, inclusive, Kansas Statutes Annotated, are by this reference incorporated into and made a part of this article, as if the same had been set out in full herein.
- 9-103 PLACE; TIME. The municipal judge shall court in a room to be supplied by the City and said court shall be held at least once monthly on the date and at the time established by the municipal judge. (Ord. 725 Sec. 1)
- 9-104 COURT COSTS; WITNESS FEES AND MILEAGE; SERVICE OF PROCESS. In each case filed in Municipal Court where there is a finding of guilty or a plea of guilty, a plea of no contest, forfeiture of bond, or a diversion, there shall be assessed court costs. The court costs shall be set by Resolution of the City Council. In addition to said court costs, the municipal judge may assess witness fees and mileage as provided by K. S. A. 12-4411 and assess the cost of service of process in any case. The court costs collected shall be paid into the General Fund of the City; provided, the municipal court clerk shall remit at least monthly such amount of assessment as is fixed by order of the Kansas Supreme Court for training, testing and continuing judicial education of municipal judges. - 9-105 COMPENSATION OF MUNICIPAL JUDGE. The municipal judge of the City of Washington, Kansas, shall receive an amount approved by the City Council and recorded in the official minutes as compensation for his services. (Ord. 725, sec 1)
